I. BACKGROUND

The "Support to Agriculture and Rural Development" SARD Project is a three-year initiative funded by the European Union, and implemented by the UNDP. The **main objective** of the project is to foster confidence building in the Republic of Moldova by targeting regions and territorial administrative units with special status. People from ATU Gagauzia, Taraclia district and neighboring communities will benefit from improved development opportunities in their localities, grasping the benefits of the National Agriculture and Rural Development Strategy. The proposed intervention will aim to address key gaps identified in the main strategic document of the region's development in line with national priorities.

The project has the following components:

Component 1: Enhanced Dialogue and Community Empowerment;

Component 2: Local entrepreneurship and SMEs development:

Component 3: Small-Scale Infrastructure Refurbishment and Promotion of Inter-Municipal Cooperation.

It will contribute to enhancing the competitiveness of the agro-food sector in the target regions, promotion of local entrepreneurship, creation of jobs and raising income; as well as increasing capacities of local communities to identify development ideas, develop and fundraise resources as well as implement development projects. The project is connecting region's authorities and structures to the national ones, facilitating dialogue and inclusion in development of national strategies, as well as connecting neighboring villages through inter municipal cooperation and implementation of the LEADER/CLLD approach.

Specific background

The component 1 of the Programme focuses on the enhancement of the capacities of local communities to create, develop and manage basic public services, as well as to rehabilitate small-scale social infrastructure to address agriculture and rural development priorities.

Because of their local knowledge and mandate, local governments, civil society and other organisations are the best placed to identify needs and constraints of target/vulnerable groups and to provide them with access to services. The **Community Mobilisation for Empowerment approach**¹ will be used and updated in line with the EU LEADER and Community-Led Local Development (CLLD) approach.

The SARD Programme envisages training and support for the creation, functioning and management of the cross-sector or commodity-specific Local Action Groups (LAGs) in rural villages from targeted regions. LAGs will ensure representation and that proposed intervention are demand-led, have the full support of local stakeholders and represent their interests. The programme will help with all necessary human resource

development, legal aspects, identification of co-financing and governance. Where appropriate, municipalities will be assisted in understanding their regulatory obligations relevant to rural development, including compliance with laws on spatial planning, environmental protection, market regulation and other laws as may be developed. It will provide all necessary training and support to ensure that all operational LAGs are networked in the country, regionally and internationally (with focus on EU countries' experience).

Last several years there was some progress in promoting and initiation of LEADER/CLLD approach in Moldova, namely:

- Several informational campaigns and study tours were organized by Donors and local NGOs,
- The first LAG was created in the North of Moldova, still in "dormant" stage,
- The National Agricultural and Rural Development Strategy (ARDS) has included in the list of actions, point 3.3.2 "Creation and operationalization of Local Action Groups of rural development, based on best practices and principles of EU LEADER Programme (pilot activity)".

The SARD Programme, starting from August 2016 initiated pilot EU LEADER approach activities through a series of sensitizing and mobilizing activities both during regional and national seminars and round tables, and 2 study tours to EU countries to learn from their LEADER experiences. As a result, first 8 LEADER initiatives were formed and a consulting company to assist those initiatives with coaching and development support was contracted, coaches and development experts were trained.

The SARD Programme seeks an experienced international consultant to continue pilot activities through the provision of LEADER/CLLD guidance, advice and supervision of the establishment of LAGs in targeted region as well as for institutionalization of LEADER/CLLD approach at the national level.

II. OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE OF WORK

In relevant to the synergic and comprehensive implementation of the three SARD Programme Components, the **major objective** of present assignment is to provide support to National, Regional and Local stakeholders to implement LEADER/CLLD measures aiming at enhancing the dialogue and community empowerment and at strengthening the territorial cooperation for rural/local economic development in Moldova, and in particular in the targeted territorial areas.

The scope of work will consist of gathering experiences, recommending the best EU LEADER/CLLD practices for the adjustment and pilot implementation in Moldova (with the specific focus on ATU Gagauzia and Taraclia district), providing a clear guidance for short term and long term interventions, and based on the piloting exercise, supporting in institutionalizing the LEADER approach in the country.

The expected output of the present assignment is:

- Based on EU and pre-accession LEADER/CLLD best practices and the SARD LEADER piloting exercise, support to the institutionalization of the LEADER/CLLD approach in Moldova provided.
- Support to the implementation of the SARD LEADER/CLLD measures with focus on ATU Gagauzia and Taraclia district, in synergy with other SARD components and with emphasis on multipliability of the process in Moldova provided. 5-8 pilot LAGs supported.
- EU SARD LEADER/CLLD Public Awareness Campaign designed and implemented.
- SARD LEADER/CLLD Lessons learned and knowledge products prepared and distributed to all relevant stakeholders.

III. KEY ACTIVITIES

In order to achieve the stated objective, the following activities are to be addressed:

1. Raise awareness and enhance the capacities on the EU rural development and LEADER/CLLD approach potential, and support its implementation in Moldova

- Conduct regular meetings with all stakeholders: Ministry of Agriculture and in particular the Rural Development Department, Ministry of Regional Development and Construction, European Union Delegation in Moldova, ATU Gagauzia and Taraclia district administrations, donor organizations active in rural development support to contribute to further development of their LEADER/CLLD approach and visions;
- Raise awareness of national and local counterparts on LEADER approach, EU, pre-accession and SARD LEADER experiences, benefits and harness their interest in it.

- Review information available on LEADER/CLLD related activities to date: reports, informational events and presentations, governmental decisions, studies and assessments completed on relevant topic on LEADER approach in Moldova;
- Organize capacity building events on EU LEADER approach/CLLD for national, regional and local stakeholders (with focus on ATU Gagauzia and Taraclia district);
- Ensure synergies between main SARD Programme components

2. SUPPORT THE PILOT-TESTING OF THE PROPOSED LEADER MODEL.

- Support and monitor the pilot-testing in 5-8 pilot LEADER areas (from formalization of LAGs to projects' identification);
- Close supervision of consulting company and coaches, and development experts assigned for mobilization/facilitation work in selected LAGs of targeted area;
- Monthly supervision meetings with coaches and development experts as well as SARD project officers;
- Support the preparation of LAGs projects' proposals to be financed;
- Based on the lessons learned of the on-going pilot-testing exercise, re-shape the proposed LEADER/CLLD approach
- Validate the findings and the proposals on LEADER/CLLD approach pilot-testing and further operationalization during a roundtable at each stage of the implementation with participation of relevant stakeholders
- In cooperation with EU Delegation experts and based on the piloting exercise contribute to the development of the detailed roadmap for LEADER/CLLD approach institutionalization in Moldova.

The whole activity (preparation, implementation and reporting) shall be carried out by December 2018 in the limits of the above-mentioned general timeframe. The assignment envisages 10 missions to Moldova (up to 120 days in total) and the costs shall be included in the financial offer as well.

6. Requirements for experience and qualifications

I. Academic Qualifications:

• University Degree in Public or Business administration, planning, economics, or other relevant field. Master Degree will be considered as an advantage;

II. Working experience:

- At least 10 years of progressive professional experience in the area of Agriculture and rural development, municipal management and/or public administration, preferably in newer EU/pre-accession/MS candidate country;
- Experience of working with the LEADER/CLLD approach on local, regional and national levels is a must, former LEADER/CLLD implementation experience in Moldova is a strong advantage;
- Experience of launching, institutionalizing and active management of LAGs is a strong advantage;
- At least 10 years of experience of working with UNDP/EU funded local development projects;
- At least 10 years of experience of working in agriculture and rural development in multi-ethnic areas is an advantage;
- Proven experience in guidelines, legal documents, training, strategic programming and project proposal drafting.

III. Competencies:

- A solid experience in community mobilization, rural capacity development and LEADER implementation;
- Experience of work in multifaceted environment, that requires to combine and formulate common goals and crystalize win-win ideas and approaches;
- Excellent public speaking and presentation skills;
- Ability to meet deadlines and prioritize multiple tasks.
- Excellent writing, editing, and oral communication skills in English, knowledge of Romanian and/or Russian is an asset.

Proven commitment to the core values of the United Nations, in particular, respecting differences of culture, gender, religion, ethnicity, nationality, language, age, HIV status, disability, and sexual orientation, or other status.
