Question 1.

Per technical specifications it is required that RAID controller can support levels 0, 1, 10, 5 and 6. Three discs can only allow setting RAID on 5 levels that is definitely enough to ensure safety and speed of database storage on server. Excluding the requirement of RAID with 6 levels will give a saving of up to 400 US Dollars.

ANSWER: specifications remain unchanged.

Question 2.

SCSI discs in item No.2 are not in production already and alternatively it would be right to use a server with same specifications as server stipulated in item No.1

ANSWER: Discs SCSI can be replaced with analogical more up-to-date type of discs.

Question 3.

Please clarify the number of client licenses needed for OS Windows Server Standard Edition.

ANSWER: 25 licenses.

Question 4.

Item No. 3 – requirement 24U for server locker, is limiting the main leading manufacturers of server equipment (such dimensions are produced by only Dell), which locker dimensions differ by 2-3U from the required one (IBM, HP, SUN). Please amend that requirement, for instance, to 22-25U, moreover, considering that all required equipment can easily fit in dimension 10U.

ANSWER: Yes, for the required equipment 22-25U is acceptable.
