Elaboration of the Integrated Documents and Records Management System for the Local Public Authorities from the Republic of Moldova (RfP15/01026)

Q1: Is a full desktop client acceptable for access to the solution?

A1: Only a full desktop client is not acceptable. The web-based approach is mandatory. However, the bidder can provide the desktop client or any other plug-ins, the web component is a must.

Q2: Will any users be connecting in over a WAN?

A2: Users shall be connected to the system only through secured channels such as VPN connections.

Q3: Is Windows Server 2008 R2 or 2012 R2 acceptable as a server operating system?

A3: Yes

Q4: Is SQL 2008 or SQL 2012 acceptable as a database platform?

A4: Yes.

Q5: Is Windows 7 or Windows 8.1 acceptable as a client operating system?

A5: Yes.

Q6: Is Office 2007, 2010, 2013 acceptable as an office package?

A6: Yes.

Q7: If the solution is accessed via a desktop client are the following mandatory requirements still applicable (i.e. is TCP/IP sufficient for communication between each layer of the solution acceptable?):

- NFRQ017 M The electronic data exchange shall use secured transport protocols.
- NFRQ021 M The transmission of data or edited messages among system components (including the client components, server components) shall be done through security mechanisms, protocols and standards, such as HTTPS.
- NFRQ024 M Session management to automatically turn off the users' sessions if no actions were performed for a specific period of time.

A7: As the web-based approach is mandatory, the abovementioned requirements are mandatory also.

Q8: In relation to the below is it a mandatory requirement for the application to include this auditing feature or would SQL Server auditing suffice?

A8: The SQL Server auditing is not suffice and the application should provide an audit feature.
