- Description:** The project supports democratic development in Moldova through strengthening of the electoral administration and electoral processes over the 2009-2013 electoral cycle.
- Dates of implementation:** September 2008 – August 2013
- Objectives pursued:**
- Improved standing and capacity of electoral management bodies and their staff;
 - An improved voter registration process;
 - Enhanced participation of citizens abroad in electoral processes;
 - Support on electoral legislation and judicial issues.
 - Increased accuracy of voter registers will increase the integrity of electoral processes;
- Benefits expected:**
- Refreshed vision for electoral administration in Moldova, building on work done since the passage of Law 101 in 2008;
 - Enhanced participation of citizens will provide for a greater degree of representation in elected bodies;
 - Greater staff motivation, streamlined procedures and improved infrastructure will enable electoral management bodies to better manage elections.
